

Outsourced vs. In-House Scanning

Document scanning is a valuable tool that allows you to:

- Send digital copies of documents anywhere in the world
- Create backups of paper documents to protect against the originals being damaged
- Convert physical files into digital files for quick and easy storage, sorting, and retrieval

Current technology has made in-house scanning so affordable that you may be wondering why anyone would consider outsourcing a scanning project. Here are three factors to help you determine whether outsourced or in-house scanning is the better decision for your next scanning job.

1. Quality

The quality you require for your scanning project may help determine whether you DIY or outsource it. Ask yourself:

- Do I need to scan a lot of pages quickly, or only a few?
- Am I scanning high-quality photos, or text-heavy documents?
- Do I need the highest resolution available, or does the image file size need to be limited for sharing or storage?

These questions will help you decide whether or not to use the services of a professional scanning company. In a professional scanning service, trained scanning technicians apply their knowledge and skills to prepare, scan, include optical character recognition (OCR) and indexing ability, and assure the finished quality you require.

2. Time

If you regularly scan large quantities of documents, are in the process of having all your active documents scanned to digital format, or want to scan archival documents, outsourcing the job will save you a great deal of valuable time and ultimately, money. It is time-consuming to scan large quantities of documents properly.

If you choose to scan in house, you will need to assign a staff member to spend hours and possibly days scanning, sorting, and managing the entire process. If you outsource the job to a professional scanning service, you'll free up your staff members to do the core tasks that allow your business to operate efficiently.

3. Equipment

Desktop scanning equipment can make in-house scanning easy and affordable for small quantities of standard-size documents. But some jobs might require large or specialized equipment and software that isn't an option for you. Most desktop scanners cannot scan oversize documents, some cannot scan to the resolution you need, and many do not allow for swift load-in.

Both outsourcing and in-house scanning can be viable solutions depending on your situation. If you consider the three factors we've shared here, you'll be on the right track to make the better choice for your company.
