Do You Have a Quarterly Records Management Checklist?

A simple checklist can help you remain effective and efficient as we approach the third quarter of the year. It can remind you about things you may have overlooked.

Here we've provided a way for you to assess your records management policy:

Organization

Have you defined and allocated your records management responsibilities?

Policy

Have you recently reviewed and presented your records management policy?

Risk

Has your records management risk level been evaluated?

Training

Is your staff current with their training, including recently enacted or changed laws, equipment, software, etc.? Have you offered an annual refresher session, retreat, workshop, or similar staff development opportunity?

Monitoring

Do you run regular checks on records security and compliance?

Control

Do you have a process to ensure personal collected data is accurate, relevant, and not excessive to your requirements? Do you regularly purge unnecessary or outdated information?

Tracking

Do you have a proper chain of custody for all records? Are retention periods observed and managed, with obsolete records being shredded at the end of their lifecycle? Do you have a Certificate of Destruction for the items shredded?

Electronic Transfer

Do you have measures in place to protect loss or theft of personal data during electronic transfer? Are your computers and network well protected?

Access

Are your records restricted to only those who require access? Are passwords changed frequently, and have personnel that no longer work there been removed from your systems?

Recovery

Is your disaster recovery process up to date, and is everyone familiar with it?

By reviewing and evaluating your records management with this checklist, you've already started on the path to better records management. Rather than try to accomplish it all at once, tend to one thing at a time by tackling the highest-priority items first. Consider designating tasks to the right leaders. And last but not least, schedule a review of this checklist three months from now and see how you've done.


